### **About the speaker:**

Melissa (Meira) Amster is an alumni parent of the UCLA Intervention Program. She was propelled into becoming an advocate after her daughter was born with Down syndrome. She found a wide discrepancy in services that children might receive correlated to how good of an advocate or how knowledgeable about services their parent was. Ms. Amster strongly believes that all people with disabilities, not just ones that have better advocates, should receive all needed available services. Ms. Amster opened the Amster Law Firm specializing in Special Education, Regional Center and In-Home Supportive Services to assist families in receiving all services and supports need for their child.

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
