



Diplomas for Former Students Who Did Not Pass the CAHSEE

- Are you eligible?
 - Did you complete all school district requirements/classes and finish grade 12 in May/June 2004 or later?
 - Were you a foster youth who completed all state minimum graduation requirements under AB 167/216 and finished grade 12 in May/June 2010 or later?
 - If you answered yes to either of these questions, Senate Bill 172 (SB 172), a new law in California, makes it possible for you to receive your high school diploma.
- How do you get your diploma?

 - All other school districts and county offices of education:
 - Call the school attended, the district office, or the county office of education and ask to speak to someone about retroactive diploma eligibility under SB 172.
- Don't delay!
 - This legislation will sunset, meaning your right to receive your diploma will end, on July 31, 2018 unless the legislature decides to extend this law.
