- LAUSD will go through the IEP (Individual Education Plan) Team Meetings for referral or consideration for an ERMHS. (Educational Related Mental Health Services)

Only a school district could request an assessment under AB3632.		Now School Districts provide assessments. Referrals can be made during the IEP meeting. Sometimes these assessments lead to services at a Non Public School and/or Residential Treatment Center.
Parents or others are unable to do so under California law; however, a parent can request such services at an IEP team meeting or request that an IEP team meeting be held in order to consider referral for AB3632.		Parents/holder of ed rights of child can request such services at an IEP team meeting.
		Under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act) parents will be advised to consult with their private physician, appropriate community or LA County agency or mental health provider for any medication management or other medical needs.
