**APRIL 28, 2009 AMENDMENT TO ITEM NO. 24: KATIE A. STRATEGIC PLAN,
MONTHLY REPORT ON THE MENTAL HEALTH SCREENING PROCESS**

On April 28, 2009, the Board ordered the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) and the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to prepare a monthly report on the mental health screening process. On January 19, 2010, the Board ordered the CEO, DCFS and DMH to report on how to reduce the time between mental health screening and the start of mental health service. In response, DCFS and DMH reviewed a sample of children's cases and on March 16, 2010 provided the Board with a plan that resulted in a redesign of the Coordinated Services Action Team (CSAT) and Referral Tracking System (RTS).

This is the ninth report updating your Board on the redesign of the CSAT implemented on October 1, 2010 in Service Planning Area (SPA) 7 and from November 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011 in SPAs 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1.

Redesign of the CSAT

The CSAT process (Attachment 1) requires expedited screening and response times based upon the acuity of a child's need for mental health services. Additionally, the CSAT process provides for the annual screening of children in existing cases with previous negative screens. Four tracks establish the process by which all DCFS children in new and currently open cases are screened and referred for mental health services.

Track	Screening Process
Track 1	Children in newly opened cases who are detained and placed in out-of-home care receive a mental health screening at case opening.
Track 2	Children in newly opened cases under Voluntary Family Maintenance, Voluntary Family Reunification or Court-supervised Family Maintenance case plans are screened at case opening.
Track 3	Children in existing cases opened before CSAT implementation are screened at the next case plan update.
Annual	Children in existing cases are screened 12 months after previously screening negative.

Based on the screening results, DCFS staff refer children for mental health services according to their acuity level and the following parameters:

Acuity	Referral Standards
Acute	Children presenting with acute needs are referred for mental health services on the same day as screening.
Urgent	Children presenting with urgent needs are referred for mental health services within one business day of screening.
Routine	Children presenting with routine needs are referred for mental health services within 10 days of screening.

Mental health service activities are initiated for referred children according to their acuity level and the following parameters:

Acuity	Mental Health Service Activity Standards
Acute	Children presenting with acute needs begin receiving mental health service activities on the same day as the referral.
Urgent	Children presenting with urgent needs begin receiving mental health service activities within no more than three days of the referral.
Routine	Children presenting with routine needs begin receiving mental health service activities within no more than thirty days of the referral.

Redesign of the Referral Tracking System (RTS)

The RTS Summary Data Report (Attachments 1a and 1b) includes 18 data elements providing the number, rate, timeliness, and acuity of mental health screenings, referral, and service response times to DCFS children in new and existing cases on a point-in-time basis.

This report reflects CSAT performance on September 14, 2011 and is a snapshot of work in progress. As such, data reported from graph to graph has some variation.


The RTS Summary Data Report of September 14, 2011 provides the progress of SPAs 1, 2, 3¹, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 from CSAT redesign implementation through July 31, 2011.

The following seven graphs depict the cumulative results to date for all three tracks across five key data indicators associated with the screening, referral and service linkage process:

¹ CSAT was implemented in the Glendora office on August 1, 2011 and the data will be included in the October 31, 2011 report.


Graph I demonstrates that of 17,346 children:

- 14,399 children required a screen (17,346 children minus those currently receiving mental health services, in a closed case, who ran away, or were abducted);
- 13,954 (96.91%) children were screened;
- 9,230 (66.15%) of those children screened were determined to be in potential need of mental health services.




Graph II demonstrates that of the 14,399 children who required screens:

- 9,230 (64.10%) children screened positive of those children requiring screens;
- 4,724 (32.81%) children screened negative of those children requiring screens;
- 445 (3.09%) children have screens pending of those children requiring screens.




Graph III demonstrates that of the 9,230 children who screened positive:


- 13 (0.14%) children were determined to have acute needs;
- 357 (3.87%) children were determined to have urgent needs;
- 8,369 (90.67%) children were determined to have routine needs;
- 491 (5.32%) children's acuity level was pending determination and/or data entry.




Graph IV demonstrates that out of 9,230 children who screened positive (minus children for whom consent was declined, whose case was closed, who ran away, or who were abducted), DCFS staff referred 8,726 (97.09%) children for mental health services.



Graph V demonstrates that children with acute needs were referred on the same day for mental health services, children with urgent needs were referred in 1 day and children with routine needs were referred in 5 days on average for mental health services.




Graph VI demonstrates that out of 8,726 children referred for mental health services: 8,381 (96.05%) children began receiving mental health service activities such as assessment, treatment, case management and consultation.²



² Differences exist in the number of children determined to be acute, urgent and routine and the total number of children receiving a mental health activity because sometimes the acuity determination and subsequent data entry occur on different dates. There is a difference in the number of children screened for urgent needs (357) and the number referred (354) for mental health services: in one voluntary case, consent for mental health services was initially denied, subsequently provided and services were received, however the case was closed and could not be updated. A review of the two other cases revealed data entry delays: the children received mental health services, but the data was not entered prior to the report.

Graph VII demonstrates the average timelines from case opening/case plan update to the start of mental health service activities (18):

- Average of 10 days from case opening/case plan update to mental health screening;
- Average of 5 days from receipt of a positive screen to a referral for mental health services;
- Average of 3 days from referral to the start of mental health service activities.



Achievements

- 96.91 percent of children screened for mental health needs;
- 97.09 percent of children referred to mental health services;
- 96.05 percent of children initiated mental health service activities;
- Completion of the Mental Health Screening Tool for routine cases reduced from 22 days prior to CSAT redesign to 10 days on average from case opening or the case plan due date; and
- Number of days from case plan opening or case plan due date to start of mental health service activities reduced from 33 days prior to CSAT redesign to 18 days on average.

Summary

This is the ninth report provided to your Board tracking mental health acuity and response rates since the redesign. CSAT processes, RTS business rules and programming, and the associated Summary Data Reports are continually modified as lessons are learned.



Track #1: Newly Detained

All newly detained children eligible for the Multidisciplinary Assessment Team (MAT) program will receive a comprehensive assessment (including mental health) and mental health service linkage. All newly detained children not eligible for MAT, or in a SPA with insufficient capacity, will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the Child Welfare Mental Health Screening Tool (CW-MHST). Based on a positive mental health screening, children will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or Service Linkage Specialist (SLS).

Track #2: Newly Open Non-Detained

All newly opened non-detained children (family maintenance or voluntary family reunification) will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the CW-MHST and, based on a positive mental health screening, referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Track #3: Existing Open Cases

All existing open cases will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the CW-MHST when the next case plan update is due or a behavioral indicator is present (unless the child is already receiving mental health services) and, based on a positive mental health screening, referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Total Initial Screens, Referrals & Activities

All children in tracks # 1, 2 and 3 will receive an initial CW-MHST upon case opening and, based on a positive mental health screening, will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Total Annual Screens, Referrals & Activities

All children that previously received negative mental health screenings, will receive an annual CW-MHST 12 months from the date of the previous negative screen or when behavioral indicators are present (unless the child is already receiving mental health services) and, based on a positive mental health screening, will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Footnotes

(1) Number of children is defined as the total number of children receiving DCFS services within each screening track.

(2) Number of children currently receiving mental health services is the number of children in an existing DCFS case who are currently receiving mental health services, defined as having received a billable mental health service activity within the previous 120 calendar days. The number of children currently receiving mental health services in track one and two is provided for information purposes only. The number of children currently receiving mental health services in track three is provided to show the number of children who are not required to be screened.

(3) Number of children requiring screens is defined as a) the number of newly detained children with a case opening in the month; b) the number of newly open non-detained children with a case opening in the month; c) the number of children in an existing open case, not currently receiving mental health services, with a case plan update due or a behavioral indicator identified requiring the completion of a CW-MHST within the month. Additionally, the number of children requiring screens may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed or by the number of runaway/abducted children in the 30 day period.

(4) Number of children screened is defined as the total number of DCFS children for whom a CW-MHST completed.

(5) Number of CSWs completing screens is defined as the number of CSWs who completed a CW-MHST.

(6) Number of days between case opening/case plan due date and screen is defined as the average number of calendar days between the DCFS case opening date or case plan due date and the completion of a CW-MHST.

(7) Rate of screening is defined as the percent of children screened out of the total number required to be screened using a CW-MHST.

(8) Number of children with positive screens is defined as the number of children determined to be in need of a mental health assessment because of a positive CW-MHST.

(9) Rate of children with positive screens is defined as the percent of children with positive screens out of the total number of children screened.

(a) Rate of acute screens is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have acute mental health needs out of the total number of children screened positive.

(b) Rate of urgent screens is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have urgent mental health needs out of the total number of children screened positive.

(c) Rate of routine screens is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have routine mental health needs out of the total number of children screened positive.

(10) Number of children for whom consent for mental health services is declined is defined as the number of children for whom consent for mental health services is declined by the parent/legal guardian, the court, and/or a youth age 12 years and older.

(11) Number of children with positive screens determined to be EPSDT - eligible is defined as the number of children identified to be in need of a mental health assessment who are determined to be insured through the Federal Medicaid, Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) program.

(12) Number of children with positive screens determined to be privately insured is defined as the number of children identified to be in need of a mental health assessment and who are privately insured (Kaiser, Blue Cross, etc.).

(13) Number of children referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children referred for mental health services through all DMH and non-DMH funded programs including MAT, Wraparound, DMH directly operated clinics, other DMH contracted providers, as well as services offered through private insurance, DCFS funded programs or any other type of appropriate mental health provider/program. Additionally, the number of children requiring referral for mental health services may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed, by the number of runaway/abducted children or by the number of children for whom consent for mental health services was denied in the 60 day period.

(14) Number of days between screening and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between a positive CW-MHST and the referral to a mental health provider.

(a) Number of days between children screening acute and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have acute mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(b) Number of days between children screening urgent and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have urgent mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(c) Number of days between children screening routine and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have routine mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(15) Rate of referral is defined as the percent of children referred to a mental health provider out of the total number with a positive CW-MHST.

(a) Rate of children screened acute is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have acute mental health needs out of the total number of children referred to mental health services.

(b) Rate of children screened urgent is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have urgent mental health needs out of the total number of children referred to mental health services.

(c) Rate of children screened routine is defined as the percent of children screened and determined to have routine mental health needs out of the total number of children referred to mental health services.

(16) Number of children accessing services is defined as the number of children referred by DCFS, based upon a positive mental health screening, who subsequently receive a mental health service, including such services as assessment, treatment, case management, consultation, etc. Additionally, the number of children required to receive mental health services may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed, by the number of runaway/abducted children or by the number of children for whom consent for mental health services was revoked in the 90 day period.

(17) Number of days between referral for mental health services and the provision of a mental health activity is defined as the average number of calendar days between referral for mental health services and the provision of a mental health service activity.

(18) Rate of mental health services is defined as the percent of children who receive a mental health service activity out of the total referred from DCFS.

(a) Rate of mental health services of acute screens is defined as the percent of children with acute mental health needs who receive a mental health service activity out of the total number of children receive mental health services.

Track #1: Newly Detained

All newly detained children eligible for the Multidisciplinary Assessment Team (MAT) program will receive a comprehensive assessment (including mental health) and mental health service linkage. All newly detained children not eligible for MAT, or in a SPA with insufficient capacity, will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the Child Welfare Mental Health Screening Tool (CW-MHST). Based on a positive mental health screening, children will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or Service Linkage Specialist (SLS).

Track #2: Newly Open Non-Detained

All newly opened non-detained children (family maintenance or voluntary family reunification) will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the CW-MHST and, based on a positive mental health screening, referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Track #3: Existing Open Cases

All existing open cases will receive a mental health screening by the CSW using the CW-MHST when the next case plan update is due or a behavioral indicator is present (unless the child is already receiving mental health services) and, based on a positive mental health screening, referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Total Initial Screens, Referrals & Activities

All children in tracks # 1, 2 and 3 will receive an initial CW-MHST upon case opening and, based on a positive mental health screening, will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Total Annual Screens, Referrals & Activities

All children that previously received negative mental health screenings, will receive an annual CW-MHST 12 months from the date of the previous negative screen or when behavioral indicators are present (unless the child is already receiving mental health services) and, based on a positive mental health screening, will be referred for mental health services through the co-located DMH staff and/or SLS.

Footnotes

(1) Number of children is defined as the total number of children receiving DCFS services within each screening track.

(2) Number of children currently receiving mental health services is the number of children in an existing DCFS case who are currently receiving mental health services, defined as having received a billable mental health service activity within the previous 120 calendar days. The number of children currently receiving mental health services in track one and two is provided for information purposes only. The number of children currently receiving mental health services in track three is provided to show the number of children who are not required to be screened.

(3) Number of children requiring screens is defined as a) the number of newly detained children with a case opening in the month; b) the number of newly open non-detained children with a case opening in the month; c) the number of children in an existing open case, not currently receiving mental health services, with a case plan update due or a behavioral indicator identified requiring the completion of a CW-MHST within the month. Additionally, the number of children requiring screens may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed or by the number of runaway/abducted children in the 30 day period.

(4) Number of children screened is defined as the total number of DCFS children for whom a CW-MHST completed.

(5) Number of CSWs completing screens is defined as the number of CSWs who completed a CW-MHST.

(6) Number of days between case opening/case plan due date and screen is defined as the average number of calendar days between the DCFS case opening date or case plan due date and the completion of a CW-MHST.

(7) Number of children screened is defined as the number of children screened out of the total number required to be screened using a CW-MHST.

(8) Number of children with positive screens is defined as the number of children determined to be in need of a mental health assessment because of a positive CW-MHST.

(9) Number of children with positive screens is defined as the number of children with positive screens out of the total number of children screened.

(a) Number of children screened acute is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have acute mental health needs out of the total number of children screened.

(b) Number of children screened urgent is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have urgent mental health needs out of the total number of children screened.

(c) Number of children screened routine is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have routine mental health needs out of the total number of children screened.

(10) Number of children for whom consent for mental health services is declined is defined as the number of children for whom consent for mental health services is declined by the parent/legal guardian, the court, and/or a youth age 12 years and older.

(11) Number of children with positive screens determined to be EPSDT - eligible is defined as the number of children identified to be in need of a mental health assessment who are determined to be insured through the Federal Medicaid, Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) program.

(12) Number of children with positive screens determined to be privately insured is defined as the number of children identified to be in need of a mental health assessment and who are privately insured (Kaiser, Blue Cross, etc.).

(13) Number of children referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children referred for mental health services through all DMH and non-DMH funded programs including MAT, Wraparound, DMH directly operated clinics, other DMH contracted providers, as well as services offered through private insurance, DCFS funded programs or any other type of appropriate mental health provider/program. Additionally, the number of children requiring referral for mental health services may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed, by the number of runaway/abducted children or by the number of children for whom consent for mental health services was denied in the 60 day period.

(14) Number of days between screening and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between a positive CW-MHST and the referral to a mental health provider.

(a) Number of days between children screening acute and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have acute mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(b) Number of days between children screening urgent and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have urgent mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(c) Number of days between children screening routine and referral to mental health provider is defined as the average number of calendar days between the day children are determined to have routine mental health needs and the referral to a mental health provider.

(15) Number of children referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children referred to a mental health provider out of the total number with a positive CW-MHST.

(a) Number of children with acute screens referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have acute mental health needs out of the total number of children with positive screens.

(b) Number of children with urgent screens referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have urgent mental health needs out of the total number of children with positive screens.

(c) Number of children with routine screens referred for mental health services is defined as the number of children screened and determined to have routine mental health needs out of the total number of children with positive screens.

(16) Number of children accessing services is defined as the number of children referred by DCFS, based upon a positive mental health screening, who subsequently receive a mental health service, including such services as assessment, treatment, case management, consultation, etc. Additionally, the number of children required to receive mental health services may be reduced by the number of children in cases that were closed, by the number of runaway/abducted children or by the number of children for whom consent for mental health services was revoked in the 90 day period.

(17) Number of days between referral for mental health services and the provision of a mental health activity is defined as the average number of calendar days between referral for mental health services and the provision of a mental health service activity.

(18) Number of children accessing mental health services is defined as the number of children who receive a mental health service activity out of the total referred from DCFS.

(a) Number of children with acute screen accessing services is defined as the number of children with acute mental health needs who receive a mental health service activity out of the total referred from DCFS.

(b) Number of children with urgent screen accessing services is defined as the number of children with urgent mental health needs who receive a mental health service activity out of the total referred from DCFS.

(c) Number of mental health services of routine screens is defined as the number of children with routine mental health needs who receive a mental health service activity out of the total referred from DCFS.
