

## TIER COMPARISON SHEET

<b>TIER I</b>	<b>TIER II</b>
<p><b>CRITERIA:</b></p> <p>EPSDT (full scope) MediCal not required</p> <p>Youth must be adjudicated as a dependent of the Juvenile Court pursuant to either: WIC 300, 601, or 602; or are qualified under Chapter 26. 5 as AB3632.</p> <p>Youth must be placed in RCL 10 or above group home w/in 60 days of transitioning to community</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-OR-</p> <p>Youth must be at imminent risk of replacement into an RCL 10 or above group home within the next 30 days.</p> <p>Must be with an identified caregiver.</p> <p><b>REFERRAL:</b> Tier I target population is youth requiring a placement decision</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Complete DCFS 174</li> <li>2. Attend RMP/TDM</li> </ol>	<p><b>CRITERIA:</b></p> <p>EPSDT (full scope) MediCal is required</p> <p>Youth must have an open case with DCFS (either Voluntary or Court).</p> <p>Youth are not necessarily at risk of placement but have multiple challenging behaviors and patterns of risk behaviors that impair them at school, community, and at home.</p> <p>Youth must be with an identified caregiver.</p> <p><b>REFERRAL:</b> Tier II population may or may not have a placement decision.</p> <p>If there is a placement decision:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consult with Wrap Liaison</li> <li>2. Complete 174</li> <li>3. Schedule and attend TDM/RMP</li> </ol> <p>If there is no placement decision:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consult with Wrap Liaison</li> <li>1. Complete 174</li> <li>3. Schedule and attend ISC Screening.</li> </ol> <p>* Some referrals may also be generated from MAT Coordination of Care Screenings.</p>
