- 22.** Recommendation as submitted by Supervisors Ridley-Thomas and Solis: Proclaim the month of October 2015 as “Girls’ Empowerment Month” throughout Los Angeles County; encourage all County employees and residents to learn more about the “Girls Build LA Initiative” by visiting <https://www.lafund.org/girlsbuildla>; find that financing of special event transportation for the screening of “He Named Me Malala” is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act; and instruct the Director of Public Works to disburse up to \$80,000 from the Top of Pot allocation of the County’s Proposition A Local Return Transit Program to The Los Angeles Fund for Public Education in order to reimburse the participating school districts for the transportation costs associated with facilitating the attendance of 7,000 students at the September 29, 2015 screening of “He Named Me Malala” at the Microsoft Theater, for which funding is included in the Transit Enterprise Fund Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget.
