Recommendation as submitted by Supervisor Ridley-Thomas: Proclaim October 2012 as “Breast Cancer Awareness Month” throughout Los Angeles County; encourage health facilities throughout the County to increase outreach and education about breast health to all women and, where possible, extend breast screening clinic hours; encourage women and men to follow the recommendations for monthly self-examination, annual check-ups and regular mammograms for early detections for breast cancer; and call upon government officials, businesses, communities, health care professionals, researchers, educators and all the people throughout the County to continue the strong commitment to detecting and curing breast cancer and to raise awareness of breast cancer by speaking with family members and friends about the importance of screening and early detection. On motion of Supervisor Ridley-Thomas, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, this item was approved.


