Whole Family Foster Homes (WFFH) and Shared Responsibility Plan (SRP)

What is it?

⚙️ A Whole Family Foster Home (WFFH) is a family home, approved relative caregiver or non-relative extended family member's home, or certified family home that provides foster care for a teen parent and her/his non-dependent child, who is trained to assist the teen parent in developing the skills necessary to provide a safe, stable, and permanent home her/his non-dependent child.

⚙️ A Shared Responsibility Plan (SRP) is an agreement between the WFFH care provider and the teen parent as to pre-natal care and the loving care of her/his non-dependent infant or child.
