ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF DCFS DISCIPLINE POLICY

POLICY ON DISCIPLINE: Age-appropriate, nonphysical and non-punitive discipline is the only form of discipline allowed. Appropriate discipline may include age-appropriate time outs, withdrawal of privileges, restrictions, discussions, etc. Physical punishment is prohibited. Physical punishment includes spanking, slapping, hitting, biting, shaking, pinching or inflicting pain on a child.

Other prohibited punishment includes humiliation, intimidation, ridicule, coercion, threats, mental or emotional abuse or any other punitive forms of discipline including interference with activities of daily living (such as feeding, sleeping, toileting, denial of family contact/visitation, provision of shelter, clothing or aids to physical functioning.)

I have read the above information and it was explained during the PS-MAPP meeting "Helping Children Manage Their Behaviors". I understand the DCFS policy of no corporal punishment.
